SUPPLEMENT TO GROUP A AND B TYPE CHARTS

(1941 edition)

(This sheet supersedes the 1939 Supplement)

The plan for listing Group A postmarks has been mentioned in the July, 1938, and May, 1939, issues of the War Cover Philatelist.

Type A-28A is Type A-28 with the APO number omitted.

Type A-56 is Type A-55 with the APO number removed.

Type A-110 has the name of the town spelled out. Another postmark of this type was illustrated in the September, 1939, issue.

Type B-17 is a British North Russia postmark used on American soldiers' mail, the T.P.O. signifying Traveling P.O.

Type A-62 is a complete illustration of the illegible Type A-62 shown on the original Group A type chart.
