Postmark Group E Markings

The American Classification System

 for listing U.S. World War postmarks

THE GROUP "E" MARKINGS

Group "E" markings (Types E-1 to E-121 are postmarks, or "townmarks," used by U.S. naval vessels and at naval shore stations in Europe. Naval and Marine shore stations in the U.S. are included in the "D" group, and those in Siberia, South and Central America and elsewhere are included in the "C" group.

Types E-1 to E-17 Ship's name and date. Types 7, 9, and 17 have widely spaced killer bars for insertion of location or slogan. Types 11 to 15 have killer bars wholly or partly removed;

Types E-21 to E-29 Ship's name combined with Censor. These combined Ship & Censor markings are considered as Group E markings only when used in lieu of other postmarks;

Types E-33 to E-35 Indefinites;

Types E-41 to E-51 U.S.NAVY at top

Types E-55 to E-63 U.S. at top, NAVY at bottom.

Types E-41 to E-63 are known to Naval collectors as "Z" types. Nothing in the postmarks indicates the name of the ship on which used;

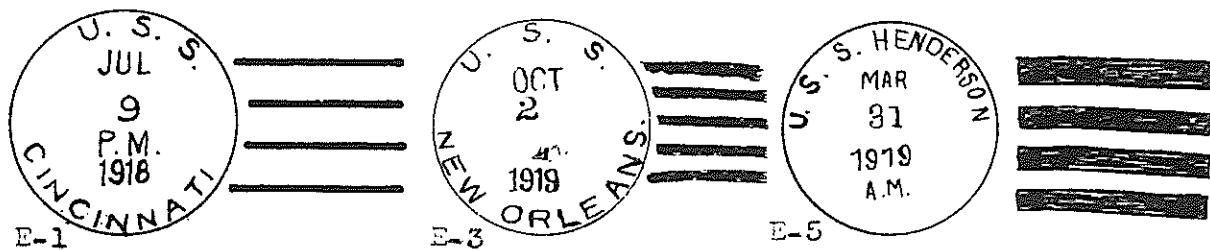
Type E-67 U.S.NAVY. at top, NEW YORK.N.Y. at bottom;

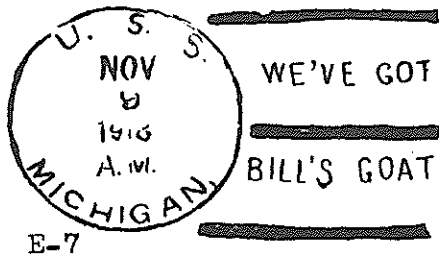
Type E-71 Flag cancel;

Types E-81 to E-87 Killer cancellations;

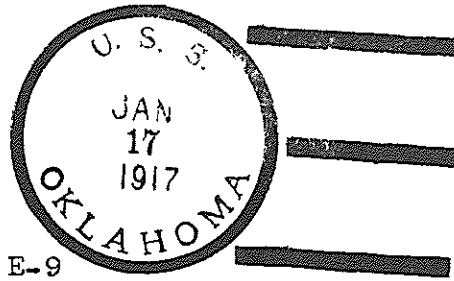
Types E-91 to E-97 U.S.NAVAL FORCES. There are several variations of Types 93 and 95;

Types E-101 to E-121 Naval shore stations in Europe.





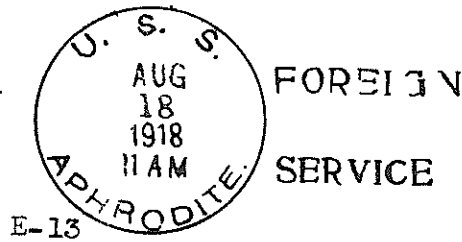
